**Town Board Action Highlights – September, 2008**

At the request of Eden Fire Chief, Chris Colvin, added the name of David Skalski to the active roster of the Eden Fire Department, pending a physical.

- Heard a presentation of the Speed Limit Reduction Report given by Dana Braun of Wendel Engineers. This report is a result of 8 months of study conducted by the Town’s Speed Limit Committee. This document, if adopted by the Town Board, will provide guidance to the Town when considering citizen requests for changes to our speed limits.
- Acting on the recommendation of Wendel Engineers, approved the Public Improvement Permit application from Tim Horton’s having to do with storm drainage for their new facility site on Route 62 and Legion Drive.
- Scheduled a public hearing for October 8<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 P.M. to discuss project suggestions for the next round of Community Development Block Grants.
- Adopted a resolution to enter into a three-year agreement with Erie County for the STOP-DWI Program which funds local law enforcement programs having to do with driving while intoxicated.
- Authorization was given to Supervisor Glenn Nellis to sign an Intermunicipal Agreement for joint sharing of a Street Sweeper and Hydro-Seeder between five communities upon review and approval of our town attorney. This equipment to be purchased with grant monies.
- At the request of a property owner on Combs Drive, the Streetlight Committee will review the current lighting and conditions on Combs Drive and make a report and recommendation to the Town Board.
