Eden Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Criteria

The Chamber's mission is to promote and advance the commercial, industrial, economic, agricultural, educational, civic and general welfare of the town of Eden and its citizens. Therefore, the Eden Chamber of Commerce, Inc. will present a five hundred (\$500.00) dollar scholarship at the Eden Central School Graduation Ceremony. A "Letter of Award" will be presented at that time.

Criteria for selection:

1. The candidate must be a permanent resident of the Eden Central School District and a member of the district graduating class.
2. The candidate must be accepted and planning to enroll in a four, three, or two year program from an accredited post-high school institution. This may include a two-year college, technical institute or business school.
3. Consideration will be given to a deserving candidate, pursuing a business, technical or agricultural program, with plans of becoming an entrepreneur (hopefully in Eden) in the future.
4. The candidate must apply for the scholarship by completing the application and attach the typed essay questions as required. The completed application must be submitted to the school Guidance office.
5. Three essay questions, typed and 500 words or less.
 - A. Please describe the career you have chosen to study, why you have chosen this field and which school or college you plan to attend and why.
 - B. Please describe all activities that you have actively participated in. Please include employment, school activities, outside activities and activities that benefit our community.
 - C. Please tell us why you deserve to be considered for this scholarship award.
